IDENTITY CHECK

When you visit TASIS England, we require that you check in with our Security team who are stationed adjacent to our main car park entrance gate on Ten Acre Lane. All adults over the age of 18 must present one form of photographic ID, for example, a driving license or passport. This check is needed to align with our procedures to ensure a safe and secure environment for our community.

BY CAR

If you plan to drive, please refer to the detailed [directions on our website](#). The main Security entrance is on Ten Acre Lane, around the corner from Coldharbour Lane and approximately 100 meters from the small roundabout at the intersection of the two streets (TW20 8SJ).

BY TRAIN

The closest train station is Virginia Water, which is 45-55 minutes from London Waterloo. So that you are not waiting for a taxi when you arrive at the station, we suggest that you pre-book a taxi. Two local companies are:

The ride from the station takes approximately five minutes and the taxi drivers know where to drop you off once you reach the School.
