Our School

TASIS England was founded by Mrs. Mary Crist Fleming in 1976 as an American school located in Surrey, England, for students ages 3-18. We are a private, independent, co-educational, boarding and day school with students from 52 countries, situated on 46 acres of beautiful Surrey land. The campus comprises buildings dating back to the 18th century, but with modern science, technology, art, theater, and athletic facilities.

TASIS England believes in supporting an expertise beyond the curriculum and developing a pure passion for learning in our students.

Our Curriculum

TASIS England offers only the most demanding academic program to its Upper School students. Our curriculum is challenging, meaningful, and progressive, by which students at TASIS can be assured of receiving an education that will prepare them for further studies at universities worldwide. In Grades 9 and 10 students follow the American high school diploma, and in Grades 11 and 12 students work towards either the IB Diploma Programme or continue the American diploma with Advanced Placement classes. In order to graduate from TASIS England, students must fulfill the following high school equivalency requirements towards a graduation certification:

- 4 years of English
- 3 years of Mathematics
- 3 years of History
- 1 year of Humanities
- 3 years of Science
- 2 years of an additional language, with a 3rd level proficiency in one language
- 2 years of Art (drama, music, art or computer graphic design)
- Physical Education in Grades 9 and 10

TASIS England's International Sections and EAL Program cater to 41% of the Upper School student body. Students who are placed in the International Sections and EAL Program are non-native speakers of English from multiple grade levels with varying degrees of language proficiency. They receive specialized instruction in their History, Science, and English courses with teachers who are sensitive to their English language needs.

Extracurricular and Sports Program

TASIS England firmly believes in combining curricular with extracurricular education to create a well-rounded student. All TASIS students must complete CAS or our Community Service Program.

An extensive afternoon activity program schedule extends the school day until 5:15 p.m. TASIS athletics boasts 16 JV and Varsity competitive sports teams, from lacrosse to basketball to baseball, that compete in European championship leagues. TASIS also offers recreational sports in conditioning, golf, yoga, badminton, horseback riding, and running club, to name a few.

There are currently over 15 different after-school clubs and 21 student-run clubs for students to take part in throughout the week, ranging from Global Issues Network to Business Club, from Giving for Good to our own TASIS Leadership Academy. We encourage all aspects of the Arts which form a large part of our extracurricular experience with concerts, orchestras, choirs, band nights, A Cappella group, art festivals, whole-school performances, minor productions, art exhibitions, and more. Our active student leadership team is responsible for coordinating an extensive and varied program of events, both on campus and in the greater London area, such as Open Mic Night, Dodgeball Tournament, and field trips to plays, museums, and cultural events.
